

Robert: Jack London's unfinished novel, finished by another. The premise is just fabulous; the leader of a gang of assassins-for-hire is hired to have himself assassinated by his own employees...chaos ensues, along with much philosphising and humour.

The moral enigma at the centre of the story is (weirdly) reminiscent of that faced by Gawain when he has to go to the Green Chapel - and in my mind the solution is the same, too.

The tone of the novel is uniform to such an extent that I did not notice the transition from London's own work to that of the person who finished the novel. Both authors were on top form for this one, which could be said to be in the same vein as *The Sea-wolf*, but with tongue stuck firmly in cheek.

It's been a while since I read any Jack London and this is one of his great unfinished novels from 1910 that has been finished by Robert L. Fish in 1963.

This book is highly relevant in these times as it is about an Ethical Assassination Bureau who only kill public figures who deserve to die for the greater good of Humanity. Say a Judge is no longer working for the good of society you could pay them and they would assassinate him, or say a bad politician etc.

The books twist is that the Bureaus chief gets the bureau hired to kill himself. The book then rips along through a chain of murders across America from New York to Chicago and Detroit and San Francisco etc all the way to Hawaii and the end.

Well the Part that Jack London wrote has a different voice as the latter is written with hindsight of what had happened in the world since Jack started the book so suddenly there are references to the forthcoming conflicts and a frankly dissappointing ending that although ingenious is somehow off with the rest of the book.

But that is a small gripe with what is a great read and has some very interesting ideas considering the times we now live in. Glad I finished it before going to Moscow as I didn't fancy carrying a title like that through Customs at the moment!!
