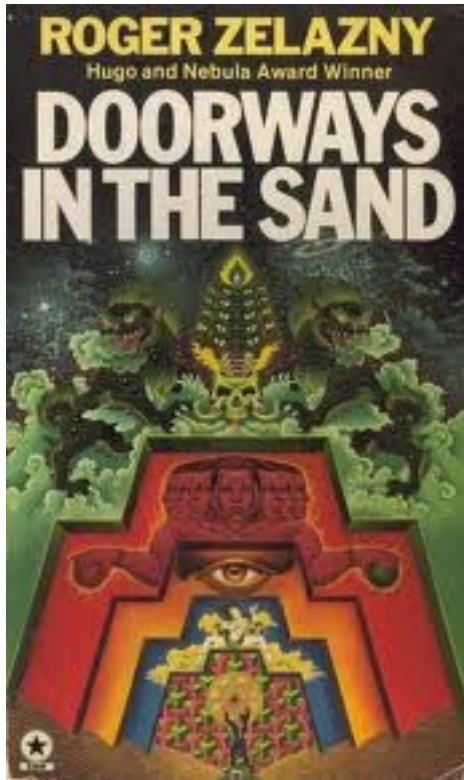

## Description

Humanity is not alone in the cosmos. The aliens have given a precious relic to the people of Earth: star-stone. The harmony of the galaxy is at stake when they discover the disappearance of their star-stone.

Likeable Fred Cassidy is an eternal undergraduate. All he thinks he knows about the star-stone is that it came to Earth in an interplanetary trade for the Mona Lisa and the British Crown jewels. Then Fred is accused of stealing the cosmic artifact, and he is pursued from Australia to Greenwich Village and beyond, by telepathic psychologists, extraterrestrial hoodlums and galactic police in disguise; as he enters multiple realities, flipping in and out of alien perspectives, through doorways in the sand.

Alazzar: I just don't get how he does it.

No matter how many Zelazny stories I read, he still finds a way to surprise and amaze me. I simply cannot fathom how he keeps track of so many characters and creates plot twists that are entirely unpredictable yet still believable within the frame of the story. And then, just when you think you have everything figured out, more information is unveiled and your appreciation for the masterful storytelling increases a thousand fold.

I really don't know what else to say about *Doorways in the Sand*, beyond these Zelazny generalizations. It's a fast read with an interesting premise and an interesting protagonist (not to mention an interesting cast of supporting characters). And, as I said, the plot twists and revelations are all superbly done.

I'll admit that the cover art of my edition (and the description on the back) made me think this would be more of a "galactic" sci-fi tale (for lack of a better term), but the vast majority of the book takes place on Earth in what could easily pass for modern-day society (there aren't a bunch of flying cars zipping around, or robots tending bars, or laser-fights). And I sort of like that about the book. I don't think you'd need to be a big sci-fi fan to like it. You could probably like it just fine if you enjoyed fantasy or even the standard thriller. (Okay, you can't *hate* SF if you're going to try this book, because there *are* still SF elements to it, but still . . .)

Highly recommended for any Zelazny fan.

Carol. : I had forgotten this gem until a question on a Zelazny recommendation sent me to my shelves to rediscover this blend of Bradbury and crime caper. Set in an Earth very similar to our own, aliens have made contact and invited us to join the galactic federation. As a token of sincerity, we're participating in an artifact exchange, lending them culturally significant objects such as the Crown Jewels and the Mona Lisa, and receiving ambiguous alien artifacts in return. Meanwhile, a perpetual university student with an affinity for heights is unwittingly pursued by various groups looking for a missing alien artifact. Thankfully, when he's [\(view spoiler\)](#) "So I

shshed while he worked on the strap. It was the most interesting hallucination I had had in a long while."

(Like Ford Prefect, the aliens seem to have mistaken the dominant life form).

Although it perhaps sounds a little silly, and occasionally even a little absurd (there's a professor who reoccurs "despite his departure from the university long ago under the cloud of a scandal involving a girl, a dwarf and a donkey"), it never goes so far afield that it can't be reeled in with real life dangers and consequences. Zelazny's writing is truly inspired. Clever wordplay based on both real life observations (the quality of coffee in the student commons), absurdity (aforementioned alien disguises), and crazy levels of creativity (stereoisotropic brandy, anyone?) and deadpan delivery combine to alternatively cause giggles and awe.

Then he challenges any absurdity with poetic imagery:

"I was taken by a glorious sensation doubtless compiled of recovery from my earlier discomforts, a near-metaphysical satisfaction of my acrophiliac tendencies and a general overlay of fatigue that spread slowly, lightly across me, like a delicious fall of big-flaked snow."

Narrative style is somewhat unusual, but Zelazny is kind enough to provide variety of well-written transitions. And in these modern times of multiple viewpoints and post-deconstructed novels, a simple scrambled timeline should be readable.

Our lead, Fred, happens to be one of my favorite types of narrators, the knowledgeable eccentric. Of course, it's a lot easier to be knowledgeable when you've spent thirteen years in university classes while avoiding a degree, much to various advisers' chagrin:

"Clocking his expression, I noted disbelief, rage and puzzlement within the first five seconds. I was hoping for despair, but you can't have everything all at once."

Fred's lengthy and varied university education gives Zelazny a chance to play with a wide range of intellectual references and ideas. I thoroughly enjoyed all of them, except perhaps the mathematical poem. References are woven in seamlessly, almost throwaway at times. There's the time Fred says at the end of a drinking binge:

"Let there be an end to thought. Thus do I refute Descartes.'  
I sprawled, not a cogito or a sum to my name."

Then there's Zelazny's brilliant creation of the Rhennius machine inversion program--first run through inverts the object left to right, and the inspired scenes that follow ([view spoiler](#)) There are anthropological references to toilet cave paintings and bead exchanges, analysis of government bureaucracy, naming of the stars of the Big Dipper, stereoisomers from organic chemistry and musings on philosophy. While I know I enjoyed reading this book in high school, more years of education and experience have given me even greater appreciation for the casual and wide-ranging references--surely that is a book that stands the test of time.

In the tradition of the caper, Fred's methods are occasionally questionable (although his ethics are solid):

"Time means a lot to me, paperwork wastes it, and I have always been a firm believer in my right to do anything I cannot be stopped from doing. Which sometimes entails not getting caught

individuals, intentional circumventors of statutes ) and alien plainclothesmen passing as neighborhood fauna. slightly escaping torture from the hoodlums and abduction by way of the aliens, Fred additionally needed to take care of a voice in his head that charges from Lewis Carroll nonsense rhymes. additional issues come up from a faculty counsellor who may do whatever to make Fred graduate, an FBI agent together with his personal mystery schedule and several events attracted to the destiny of the lacking superstar stone. A moment alien artefact is introduced, really all at once and with little explanation. The Rhennius desktop is a type of black field gadget that resembles a Moebius strip and is used to turn fact left to correct and inside-out ( insert extra Lewis Carroll reflect references here). Frank is going into the laptop by accident on purpose, driven through the telepathic voice inside of his head, and the silliness is dialed up one other notch, referencing between different issues the stereoscopic houses of the grain alcohol molecule: i made a decision little extra antitelepath drugs will be in order. For all of the lightness of tone, the hunt turns into harmful for Fred and for his shut friends, and the instant arrivess while he needs to take lifestyles heavily and truly paintings at fixing the puzzle. sooner than we received there, with a scene worthwhile of the camerawork of Hitchcock in Vertigo , Zelazny could not restrain his humorous bone and introduces yet another wacky personage : Dr. M'mrm'mlrr is an alien telepathic analyst, who practices a strategy often called attack therapy. (insert extra Hitchcock scenes of unconscious terror). The constitution of the radical is itself unconventional / experimental, with every one bankruptcy beginning with a cliffhanger second from later within the timeline, going again to the occasions previous the acknowledged moment, and finishing with a special cliffhanger. the fashion borrows from the noir novels of the 1940's, with a few wild similes (for example, the Outback : The geographical region struck me as an outstanding position to ship trainee saints to get what was once coming to them ) and with a few snappy exchanges of wit: "However, because it is all contingent at the result of the analysis, it might be an workout in redundancy to aspect some of the hypotheses which can must be discarded." "In different words, you're not going to inform me?" "That pretty much sums it up." lots of the ebook might be thought of a light-weight via science-fiction hardcore fans, however the ultimate chapters greater than made up for any perceived loss of seriosity, and justify the Hugo and Nebula nominations the ebook earned. nonetheless with a mild touch, yet with a go back to the poetic imagery of his past novels, Zelazny asks the large questions about humanity's position in a populated Universe the place not just we're now not alone, yet we're not on the most sensible of the evolutionary scale, technologically or socially - wise. the difficulty with you humans in anthropology, for your whole speak of cultural relativism, is that the very act of overview instantly makes you are feeling more advantageous to no matter what you're evaluating, and also you evaluation everything. we're now approximately to be evaluatees for a time, anthropologists included. i believe that has hit you more durable than you can be prepared to admit, on your favourite sector of thought. i might then say, endure up and examine whatever from it. Humility, if not anything else. rather than a dystopian imaginative and prescient of everlasting clash and Darwinian survival of the strongest, the writer prefers to have a good time diversity: "Are there many... constructing worlds... resembling my own?" "Yes," he said. "There is kind of a crop of them. New ones maintain turning up all of the time. an excellent

thing, too – for everybody. we'd like that variety – all these viewpoints and distinct methods to the issues lifestyles serves up anyplace it occurs." On a private level, Fred Cassidy has reached the purpose the place he has to depart the protection of the tutorial circles and do whatever worthy for society, to climb one other wall, to discover the unknown: when you've got to do something, it really is lucky if it may be anything interesting, whatever greater than a bit enjoyable. All these races out there, somewhere, touching on which we now knew subsequent to not anything – i used to be going to have a chance to mine the unknown, with a bit of luck to fetch forth anything of understanding, to contemplate the exotic, to rework the familiar. For related authors / books utilizing somewhat comedy, a favorable attitude and a fascination for brand new worlds and new ideas, i might nominate Robert Heinlein and Lois McMaster Bujold. and that i could say see you later to Fred with a little stereoisotropic booze and with the phrases of 1 of his academics / counsellors: So I drink to you currently and to the time that has transfigured us. preserve climbing. that's all. retain climbing, after which cross a bit higher.
