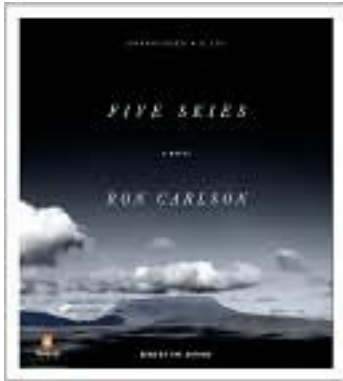

## Description

Beloved story writer Ron Carlson's first novel in thirty years, *Five Skies* is the story of three men gathered high in the Rocky Mountains for a construction project that is to last the summer. Having participated in a spectacular betrayal in Los Angeles, the giant, silent Arthur Key drifts into work as a carpenter in southern Idaho. Here he is hired, along with the shiftless and charming Ronnie Panelli, to build a stunt ramp beside a cavernous void. The two will be led by Darwin Gallegos, the foreman of the local ranch who is filled with a primeval rage at God, at man, at life.

As they endeavor upon this simple, grand project, the three reveal themselves in cautiously resonant, profound ways. And in a voice of striking intimacy and grace, Carlson's novel reveals itself as a story of biblical, almost spiritual force. A bellwether return from one of our greatest craftsmen, *Five Skies* is sure to be one of the most praised and cherished novels of the year.

## Insightful reviews

Elise Hamilton: I struggled with my rating for *Five Skies* and finally gave it a 5. It's not on my hard-to-get-onto "Best Books Ever" list, but it's not far from that. It's a very quiet book, and its power and impact took me by surprise. I'm not sure I've ever read a novel that focuses almost exclusively on male characters and the friendship that develops between them, in *Five Skies*, over the summer in which three men build a stunt ramp over a deep river gorge in Idaho. All three are broken men, each with very different pasts and reasons for their current state of despair, but they each seek absolution and come to find it as so many prophets have done: in the wilderness, in isolation. While they begin the summer in isolation, both from "civilization" and from each other, they are integral in the process of helping each other heal. *Five Skies* is, for lack of a better word, biblical. Each man is haunted by his past and cannot still the voices in his head that torment him. Yet as they work together, and the meditation of hard physical labor begins to work its curative power, they find a way to share their confessions, and to help each other find the forgiveness they seek. The men form the best kind of family, one in which the members support and respect one another, yet teach and challenge each other to be the best they can be. As I understand it, Ron Carlson is primarily a short-story writer and this is his first novel in 30 years. Though collected short-stories is not my preferred genre, I'll seek out other books by Carlson and will hope for another novel that doesn't take 30 years to produce.

Steven: Something about this novel drew me for a long time. It was on my wish list for over a year, and when I finally bought it, I started it immediately. I don't know why. It isn't the kind of book I'd normally be in a rush to read, but for some reason the idea of these three guys coming together and battling personal demons -- metaphorical demons, even -- really compelled me. Demons. Compel. See the influence of what I usually read? haha

Anyhoo, I loved this book up until the end. The three characters are beautifully drawn and their

interaction with one another seems very real, the way these kind of men would talk to each other. Ron Carlson's writing is lyrical and sweeping and minute and beautiful. Carlson moves from poetic descriptions of the vastness of the Idaho desert to the sparse dialogue in a way that perfectly contrasts the men and their surroundings, while at the same time showing how they fit together perfectly.

I had pretty much forgotten about the title of the book until the phrase "five skies" is used toward the end. Once it came up, though, the light bulb went on and I understood it. It's a very appropriate title.

My problem with the ending is that it is simply too abrupt. I can't go into why I think that without spoilers that would just ruin the book, so that's all that I'll say. The defining moment happens without anyone actually seeing it, and then the wrap-up comes too soon.

I listened to this as an audio book. As beautiful as Carlson's prose is, he was not the best choice to narrate the book. It was as though he was trying to keep his voice detached. The narration came across as flat, without a variance of inflection or accent for different characters. It wasn't as bad as, say Toni Morrison reading *Beloved*, but the audio would have been more enjoyable with a narrator as skilled in his craft as Carlson is with a keyboard. This is a book I will likely buy in paper to let the voice in my head reread.

David: There's a lot of emotion in this book for something that is, at least on the surface, about three guys building a ramp in nowhere Idaho. I love the lines too. Quiet, strong, and nothing that isn't needed. I do like me some Ron Carlson.

Vera Marie: As I learn *5 Skies* I spotted I used to be studying anything approximately my father, that I had by no means thought of before.
