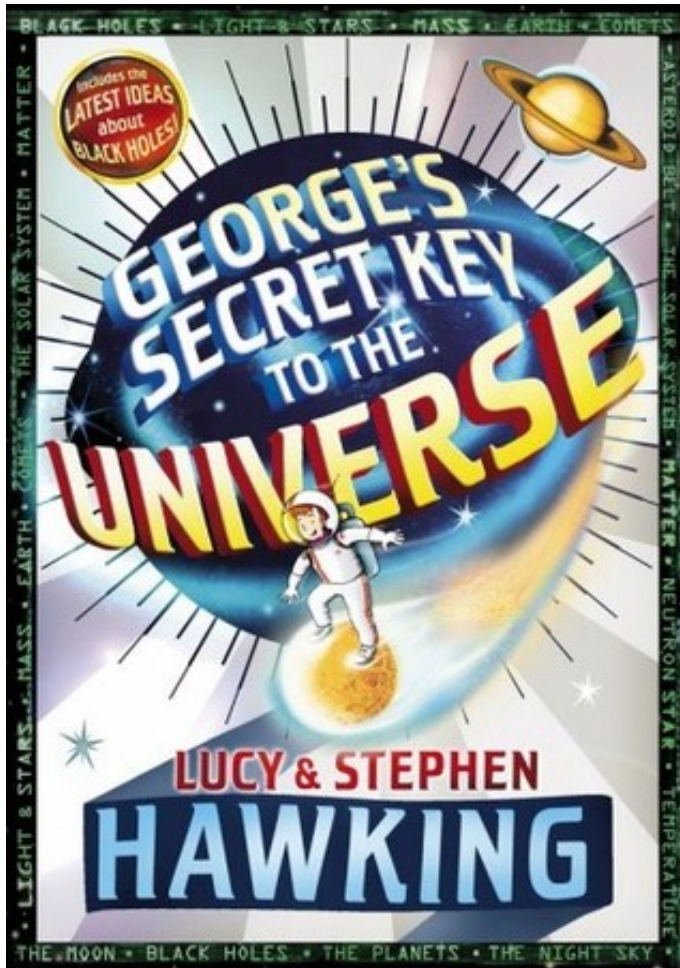

Agatha: Recommended! Kind of like the Magic Tree House books, but it teaches science and outer space, instead of history or biographies. Both my 6yo daughter and I found it very interesting, compelling, and readable! (I read it out loud to her.)

George and his parents live in England and his parents are very into saving the Earth and eschewing technology. They have told him to stay out of the backyard of the house next door, which, apparently, is abandoned. The previous owner, an old man, went mysteriously missing and no one knows why. But one day George's pet pig escapes into that backyard and George must run after him. He spies lights on in the kitchen, enters (following the pig) and meets a little girl (Annie) and her dad (Eric) who have apparently moved in! Eric is a scientist and he has a very powerful computer named Cosmos through which one can enter a portal into outer space. (Eric's wife and Annie's mom Susan is away helping take care of Annie's sick granny.) Eric, Annie, and George go on lots of adventures into outer space and Annie and Eric teach George new things about each planet, comets, meteors, asteroids, solar systems, galaxies, and black holes as they travel.

A mystery ensues involving a malcontent teacher at their school who, with the help of some local bullies, seems to be trying to steal Cosmos for his one malevolent gain. Eric falls into a black hole and it is thought that he'll never get out again. Like we were all taught, George thinks that it is impossible to escape from a black hole. But not true! Recent discoveries (true story) have shown that a black hole is in fact NOT eternal and that, as it breaks down (over billions and billions of years) all of the matter which was sucked into it is gradually expelled in small particles; once it starts expelling it, it gets faster and faster. Cosmos is able to put Eric's particles back together again and the day is saved.

A quite interesting read! There are two more in the series which my daughter has asked me to get at the library, so I'll now go on to look for #2! (I certainly learned new information and/or

solidified my own understanding of these things – was much easier to “get” in the form of a story rather than some boring ol’ text book. It made me personally more interested in outer space, a topic which previously sort of left me cold and “eh.”)

PS I also liked how Annie was a key character, so it wasn’t all “boy-focused” the way it would have been if there was just George. However, I did note that, in the end, it was George who discovered Eric’s notes re black holes not being eternal. . . I sort of wished that could have been Annie’s discovery (at least b/c I was reading this to a young girl)or, at least, that they could have done this together. I’ll see how the next 2 books are on this. . . .

I still remember getting a few sample chapters of this book in England in a magazine, yet I never got around to reading it. As I am obsessed with physics and learning about space, I thought this would be a good book to read and I can safely say I absolutely adored it!

George's Secret Key to the Universe is about George, a little boy who is the son of two eco-friendly, planet saving activists who think science and technology are out to destroy the world. When George goes next door to rescue his pet pig Freddy who escaped to the house next door, a place where George has been forbidden to go, he meets Annie and Eric. Annie is a little girl with a vivid imagination who lives with her scientist dad Eric and her mom. When George becomes friends with them, they open him up to the whole fantastic world of science and let him experience being in space first hand with their fantastic computer that is able to send Eric, Annie and George to outer-space, in order to try and find a new habitable planet. But however, with the power Eric possesses due his extraordinary computer, there are evil forces out there who will stop at nothing to get Cosmos the computer and use it for a despicable purpose.

I had so much fun reading this book! Sometimes I'm quite wary of reading middle-grades, as a lot of them are just a bit too young for me to enjoy but I really enjoyed this! I love the science lessons that were placed throughout the novel as well as the full-colour illustrations that showed the images taken from outer-space. I loved learning all these new fantastic things, and the story in itself was so imaginative and colourful!

I would absolutely love to be George and by the mere press of the button, enter into space, riding a comet and bypassing Jupiter, Saturn, the Moon and all the other planets/moons/space things out there. You could so vividly picture stepping out of the portal and seeing the inky black sky and the thousands of stars and colourful planets. The characters were very lovable. I loved George and his enthusiastic, positive personality and the way he loved learning new things. Annie was an adorable character with an extremely vivid imagination and really had her own personality and interesting sense of style. George's parents were sweet too, and you could see how driven they were to save the planet. Freddy the pig was lovely, as well! I connected with all the characters

This is also good to offer to young scientists, and it would be a good family audiobook...if the family is interested in physics.

Hawking introduces concepts like black holes and basic physics throughout the book. Although these are woven into the storyline (George's neighbor is a scientist, George is working on a science project, etc.), these scientific passages can become distracting.
