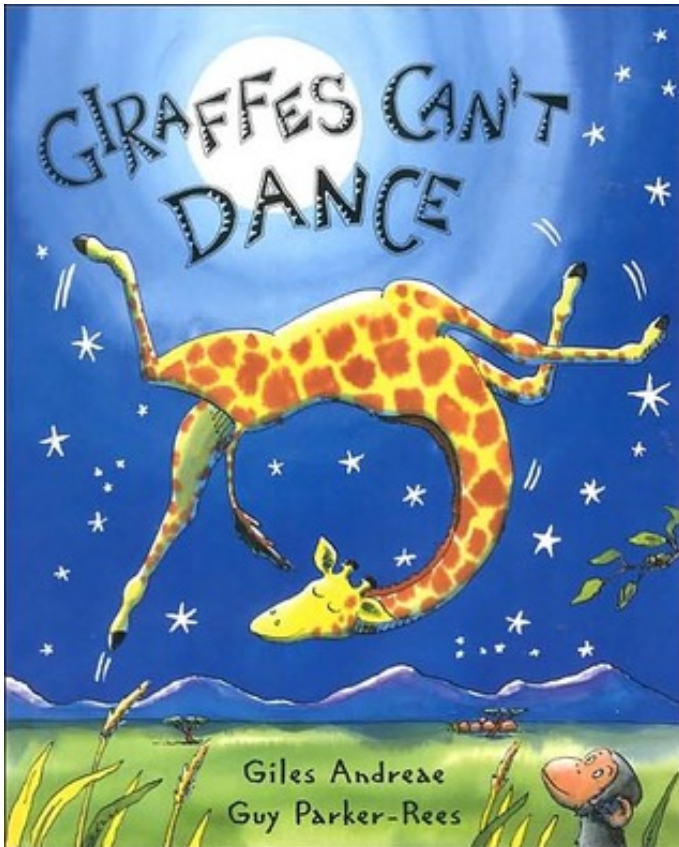

Qurat: This is story told in a rhythmic tone, about a clumsy giraffe called Gerald. After Gerald's humiliation at the Jungle Dance, he meets a wise cricket who encourages him to discover his own dance moves. This is a wonderful book as the text has its own rhythmic beat when it is read aloud, and children can discover rhyming words and language that can be used for such writing.

The illustrations create a humor throughout the story which is ideal for children at the age of 4. They are able to stay engaged with the different characters and recognise different animals. The book portrays the element of confidence and cheerfulness, eventhough Gerald was discouraged by other animals. Therefore, children who read this book can learn the importance of confidence, as Gerald is represented as a great character who sets an example of someone who finds his way to do what he felt was impossible. Confidence, encouragement and motivation are the key factors in this book and shows children that anything is possible.

In a classroom setting, children should be asked questions about the story and any difficult vocabulary should be defined throughout. This book is ideal for story time during the end of the day, as it can create a calm yet enjoyable environment for children. Role-play is also an activity that the children can participate in by pretending to be Gerald, this would be to emphasise the importance of confidence and reaching goals, in Gerald's case, it was his dancing. Writing poems and identifying words that rhyme with each other can also be a fantastic task for the children, not only would this improve their vocabulary, but also understand different forms of writing.
