

Robert: This story has the frenetic pace of a six-year old boy that consumed two pounds of Halloween candy, gone into hyperglycemic shock, been revived in the middle of the operating room with paddles, and given a shot of adrenaline and a Snickers bar. Jack Reacher, the ultimate man's man, leads the charge. He carries nothing but the clothes on his back, a wad of cash, and a toothbrush jammed in his pocket. After use, he tosses his clothes in the trash, and visits the local thrift store. While they may lack depth, the sentences have a punch that hits harder than Mike Tyson in his prime. The dialogue, while certainly not fancy or flowery, does a more than adequate job of delivering the uppercut.

While it may seem farfetched to some, the plot works well with the character, and the small town atmosphere of the south. Revenge is a dish best served cold, and Jack Reacher is one stone cold piece of mastery. It's MANfiction at its finest, and it reaches the ultimate crescendo with more brilliance than a five figure Fourth of July fireworks display.

He's finishing breakfast in a small town diner when four cops swarm in and arrest him for murder. And off we go!

Reacher finds himself trying to solve the murder mystery 'from the inside" to prove his innocence. Reacher excels at deduction and sifting evidence due to his former experience.

The Reacher series is somewhat violent but the plots are good and complex and the pace is fast, with decent characterization. Jack Reacher is NOT a nice guy---but he would be the person you want at your side if you were in trouble.

If you have not read any of this series, I recommnd trying a few. Fans of mysteries and action adventure should like the series. NOt recommended for mystery fans under 18 due to the level of violence.

Btw, this first novel is tol in the first person; most of the later novels are in the third person, which I prefer. Also, they can be read in any order as each story stands alone.
