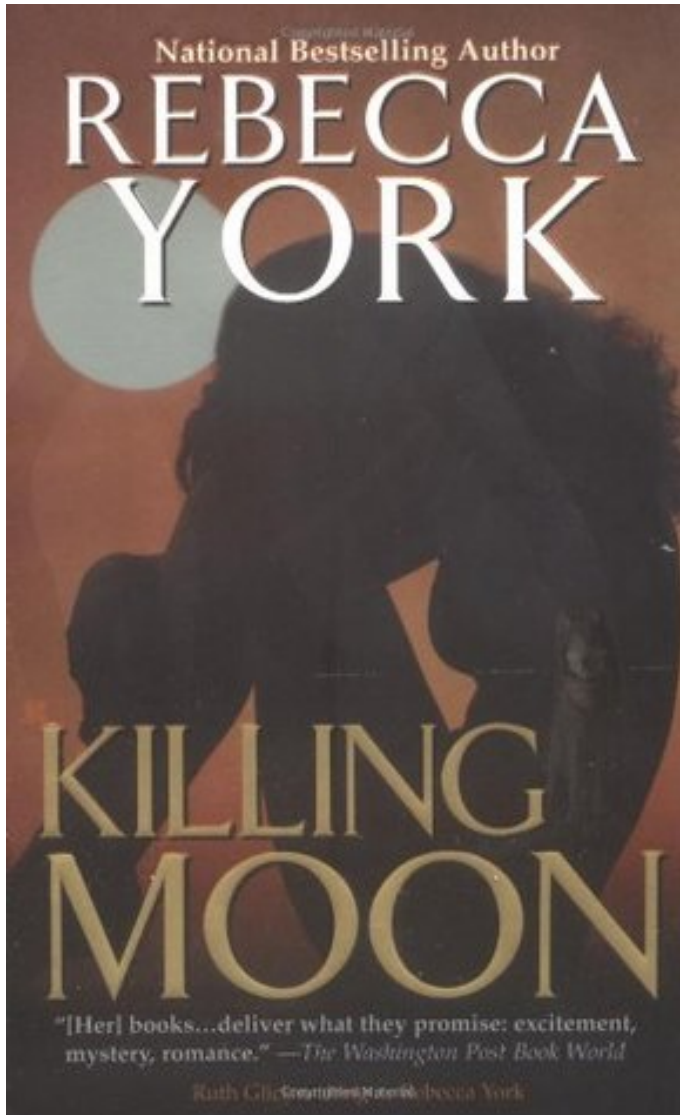

Robin: This is about a werewolf named Ross and Megan who works for Bio Gen a research facility for DNA type testing. The premise of the story was good, Megan goes to Ross' house to do a blood test and get his genetic line. She finds him naked on the floor bleeding and out of his mind. She being a former physician decides to stay and help him. He has been shot. She nurses him for days and he comes around. The story really takes off from there with a serial murderer Ross is trying to catch and Megan getting caught up in all the action. The problem I had with the story was the character building or lack of it. We really don't see too much about Ross and he seems almost distant like the author didn't want to give too much of his personality away. He seemed a bit bland to me. Megan on the other hand had a little more depth to her. I would have liked to have seen the author build Ross' character a bit better and make him more interesting.

S.L.: I freely admit that I like werewolf books. They have always been my "monster" of choice. Oh, vampires will do in a pinch, but werewolves hold more appeal to me.

And I've met Rebecca York and found her to be a very friendly, very kind woman, so the combination of her writing and my favorite supernatural creatures was set up to be a good one.

Ross Marshall is a private detective. He investigates crimes in ways that "normal" PIs can't, given his ability to shapeshift and take better advantage of his senses of smell and sight and hearing. He comes from a family of werewolves, one in which the odds of him making it to manhood have never been good. He's been living on his own, half hiding from the world, in an

attempt to keep from taking a mate.

Fate has other plans and leads Dr. Megan Sheridan to him. Shot by a man he's investigating, he's not strong enough to scare or send her away when she finds him feverish and in need of medical care in his cabin. A genetic researcher, Megan went out to his cabin to collect samples for a test Ross requested, but soon finds herself wanting to help this stubborn and strong-willed man.

I liked the werewolf mythos in this world, tragic though it might be. (Girl children die at birth, boys have a fifty-fifty chance of surviving past adolescence.) It's unique and it makes sense that Ross would want to find a cure and want to avoid contact with human women for as long as possible.

I liked Megan. She was capable and smart and just as strong-willed and determined as Ross. I also really liked Jack Thornton, the detective Ross has been working with for a while. I'm hoping that in the future books, he gets a story of his own.

However, there's something missing in this book that kept me from absolutely falling in love with it. It felt like I, as the reader, was being kept at a little distance from the characters. I never fully engaged with either Ross or Megan, and maybe that's because they were both so determined to be reserved and controlled with each other for so long.

I admit that I considered skimming the second half of the book. I'm glad I didn't, as the story's pretty well put together. I just wish I'd felt more compelled to read every word.

Paranormal Romance: As a scientist and a non practicing doctor, the heroin has spent her life proving to herself and her abusive father that she's better than either of them give her credit for. She's timid and will avoid conflict when she can, remaining quiet about her unhappiness with her job and her crack head sister. But when she makes a house call to do a genetic makeup for a client, she finds herself in some serious conflict. The hero has been shot while investigating the disappearances of 2 young girls and now has a high fever and a bad infection. She can't physically make herself leave the man when doing so will surely mean his death. In his feverish delirium, he pulls a gun on her, rambles on about mates and the fact that she's got to leave before it's too late. Despite her unease with her patient she stays and nurses him back to health. When he comes to, he's less than welcoming. The hero has lived a tortured life starting with his abusive father and the fact that his werewolf genes has caused the death of his brothers and sisters. He's terrified of finding his mate, the one woman whom he will do anything to possess because he's terrified of becoming his father. So, despite the instant and passionate attraction he feels for the heroine, he's very cold and distant for the most of the book.

Personally, I wouldn't have the strength to stay around after being treated the way the hero treated the heroine but she was stubborn and selfless to a fault. Slowly and bit by bit the hero begins to warm to her and when his murder case and his love affair clash together, he'll do anything to protect his woman. I absolutely loved this story. I loved the hero. He was so tortured and cold yet strangely warm at times. You can so feel his internal struggle as he tries to find his instincts in a bid to keep her safe. The heroine was so loyal and despite her fear for him and of him at times, she never gave up on him. This book was the perfect mix of drama and romance

without being melodramatic. The issues are real but their bond is real as well. I loved reading about them trying to figure it all out. Super awesome read.
