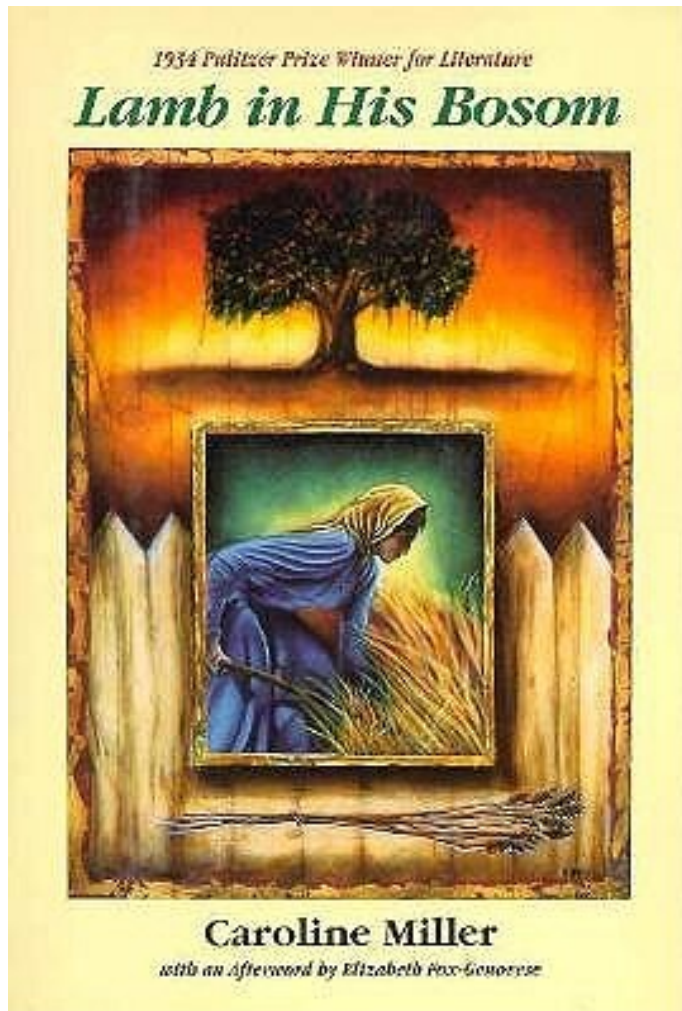

## Description

In 1934, Caroline Miller's novel *Lamb in His Bosom* won the Pulitzer Prize for Literature. It was the first novel by a Georgia author to win a Pulitzer, soon followed by Margaret Mitchell's *Gone With the Wind* in 1937. In fact, *Lamb* was largely responsible for the discovery of *Gone With the Wind*; after reading Miller's novel, Macmillan editor Harold S. Latham sought other southern novels and authors, and found Margaret Mitchell.

Caroline Miller was fascinated by the other Old South—not the romantic inhabitants of *Gone With the Wind*, but rather the poor people of the south Georgia backwoods, who never owned a slave or planned to fight a war. The story of Cean and Lonzo, a young couple who begin their married lives two decades before the Civil War, *Lamb in His Bosom* is a fascinating account of social customs and material realities among settlers of the Georgia frontier. At the same time, *Lamb in His Bosom* transcends regional history as Miller's quietly lyrical prose style pays poignant tribute to a woman's life lived close to nature—the nature outside her and the nature within.

## Insightful reviews

Ben: Pulitzer 1934 *Lamb In His Bosom* is Caroline Miller's novel of re civil war south but rather than the perspective of Margaret Mitchell's book which would win a few years later and focused on the Southern aristocracy this is about the more common white farmers, the pioneers. In fact it reminded me a lot of Conrad Richter's *The Town* series but set in Georgia. It is the story of Cean (pronounced see-Ann) Carver her marriage and her family. She is a classic farmer's wife farming having children, 17 of them. There are a lot of religious overtones in the book as they felt that everything they did or didn't do was rewarded or more commonly, punished by God. Miller's prose and character development is superb and I thought this was a wonderful window into this part of American culture.

Cean's brother's figure prominently in the book creating a soap opera plot that involves her sister-in-law - a baby born outside the marriage and the second brother. As in *The Town* series - the folks are hardy - death of children was not uncommon as was dying from disease. It's amusing to read these books and have the characters think of themselves as old at the age of 40.

Mr. Kovach: This is a very powerful and beautifully-written book about rural Georgia in the 1800s. (It was Margaret Mitchell's favorite book!) If you are interested in American history, especially historical fiction about the antebellum South, check this out. (Some of the characters' ways of thinking are backward and offensive by our standards, especially regarding racial issues, but it is a book about uneducated people from a time long ago, and it can be valuable to see how far we've come racially, socially, medically [if you cut your foot back then and got an infection, you basically died], and in so many other ways. It's definitely better to live in our time than in any other.) This book won a Pulitzer and as sometimes happens, I'm glad I read it just because it won a Pulitzer. I've read quite a few fantastic books just because they won a Newbery, too. DON'T read only books that won one of these two awards, but DEFINITELY mix some in!

Linda Woodworth: This title kept being mentioned in different places and decided to read. It was the first Pulitzer-winning book from Georgia - before *Gone With the Wind*. Really good tho not perfect. It is a rich and authentic depiction of life in South Georgia pre-civil war - not the Scarlett O'Hara life but the more average back woods close to the earth kind. Heading to South Georgia soon and will be seeing it with new eyes.

Steven: this is often a unprecedented book. it really is hardly ever recognized today, however it is gorgeously written--poetic and lyrical--and amazingly wise, when you consider that the writer used to be all of 30 whilst she wrote it. Her photo of the antebellum South is definitely observed, and the language of the characters turns out spot on. I nonetheless listen a number of the words she makes use of coming from the mouth's of my partner's relations in rural western North Carolina. it is no ask yourself that this booklet gained the Pulitzer Prize and used to be Margaret Mitchell's favorite. it is also much better than Mitchell's "*Gone With the Wind*," which feels like an inexpensive potboiler subsequent to this really good piece of literature.
