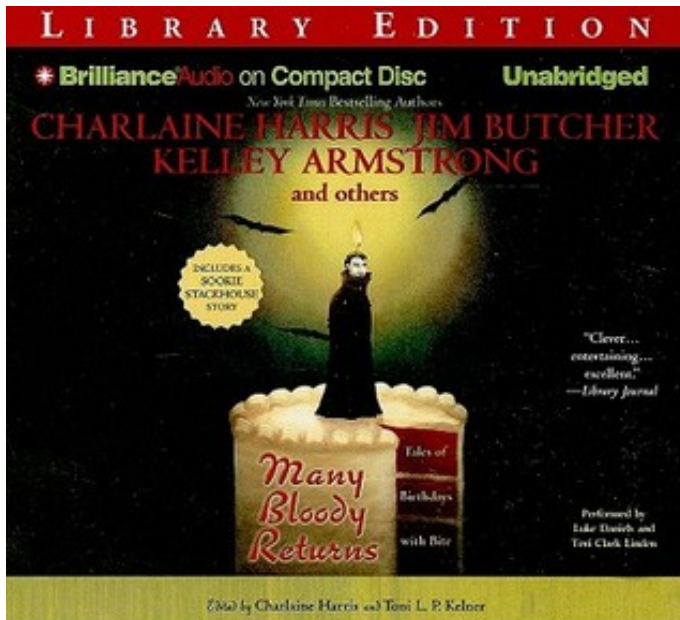

National bestselling author P.N. Elrod's hardboiled vampire PI Jack Fleming, from The Vampire Files, infiltrates a suspicious séance on the eve of the dearly departed's birthday in "Grave-Robbed."

And in award-winning author Toni L.P. Kelner's "How Stella Got Her Grave Back," vampires become amateur sleuths (with breaks for feeding) to solve the murder of a Jane Doe.

Suspenseful, surprising, sometimes dark, sometimes humorous – these and eight more frighteningly original stories will ensure you'll never think of vampires or birthdays quite the same again.

Insightful reviews

Ricki: This anthology contains 14 stories from famous authors that mix vampires and birthdays. Some of my favorite stories were the funny ones, such as "I Was a Teenage Vampire" by Bill Crider, and the mystery ones, such as "Grave-Robbed" by P. N. Elrod. Of course, I really enjoyed the funny mystery "How Stella Got Her Grave Back" by Toni L. P. Kelner, which was the perfect ending to the collection.

Tatiana: 13 stories in this anthology have a theme in common - vampire birthdays. I didn't really read the entire book, simply because after a few failures I realized that I rarely like anthologies and only enjoy the stories written by the authors I know. Therefore out of 13 short stories published in this book I read only 2.

"Dracula Night" by Charlaine Harris - a Sookie story about Eric's party in honor of Dracula's

birthday. In one word, disappointing. While I enjoyed some insight in vampire traditions, etc., overall it was a rather superficial and silly story with very little character development or plot. Eric acted completely out of character and Sookie was her usual self - all hair, nails and dresses. Not a real treat for Sookie fans.

"Twilight" by Kelley Armstrong - an Otherworld story about a minor character first introduced in "Stolen" - vampire Cassandra. Cassandra is approaching another anniversary of her rebirth and to continue her existence, she must kill. Only Cassandra doesn't want to kill and possibly doesn't want to live. A great story. Although only about 30 pages long, it provides rich background, great mythology, nice plot, and even some romance. I really wish Armstrong would write an entire novel from Cassandra's POV. I am curious to see her interpretation of vampire lore.

2 stars for the first story and 5 for the second - this is approximately 3 stars on average.

Robin: I got this book because three of the stories were part of on-going series that I'm reading. I didn't bother with the other stories, so I can't comment on them.

Charlaine Harris wrote a story about Sookie Stackhouse receiving an invitation to the annual birthday party for Dracula at Fangtasia. The story was cute, but only 20 pages long.

Kelley Armstrong wrote a story about vampire Cassandra DuCharme. Cass must make at least one kill every year on the day of her re-birth, or she will die. I was excited to read this story from the Women of the Otherworld series. What a disappointment. This story was really depressing.

The last story I read was by Jim Butcher. It was part of his Dresden Files series. Harry Dresden tracks his brother, Thomas, down at the mall in order to give him his birthday present. He finds a group of people being held by Black Court vampires. Great story. It felt like it was full length instead of only 40 pages. It wrapped up nicely...I just wish it could have gone on and on.

Elizabeth: This used to be a good mixture of authors, every one of whom had their very own tackle the vampire mythos. Of course, my favorites have been the tales that includes universal characters, like Charlaine Harris' Sookie story, "Dracula Night," and Jim Butcher's "It's My Birthday, Too." I additionally discovered a couple of new authors, as well. Overall, a enjoyable learn that i feel so much vampire lovers will enjoy!
