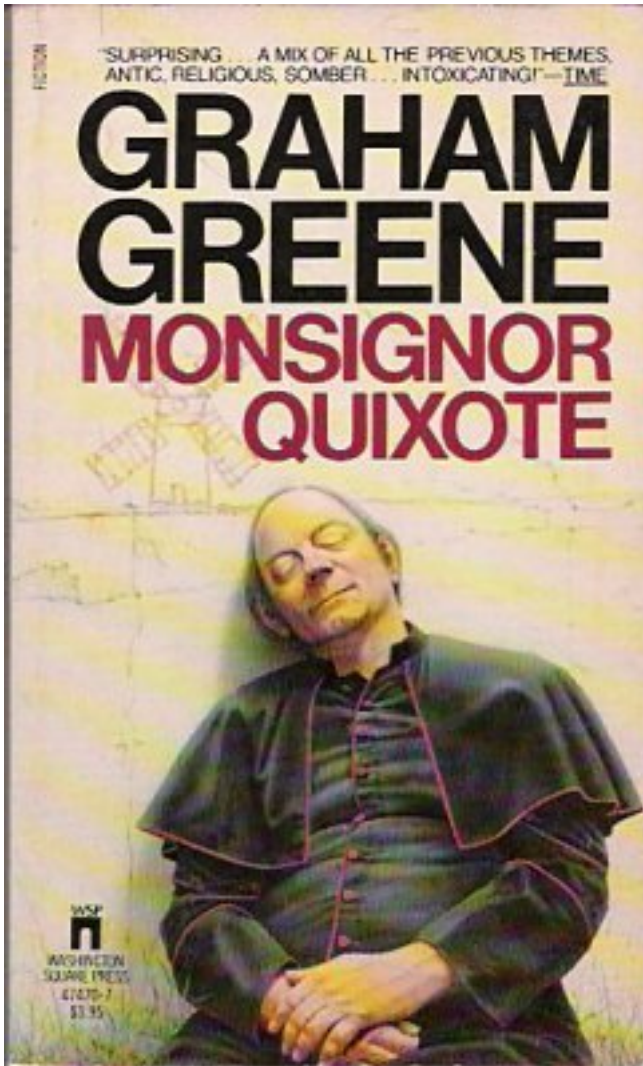

In this later novel by Graham Greene—featuring a new introduction—the author continues to explore moral and theological dilemmas through psychologically astute character studies and exciting drama on an international stage. The title character of *Monsignor Quixote* is a village priest, elevated to the rank of monsignor through a clerical error, who travels to Madrid accompanied by his best friend, Sancho, the Communist ex-mayor of the village, in Greene's lighthearted variation on Cervantes.

Louisa: "Fact and fiction again, one can't distinguish with any certainty". I feel like I missed a lot of things in this novel, not having read Cervantes' original *Don Quixote*, but even without that, this was an enjoyable read.

"Because once when I was young I partly believed in a God, and a little of that superstition still remains. I'm rather afraid of mystery, and I am too old to change my spots. I prefer Marx to mystery, father."

Stephen Gallup: This is a deceptively simple novel about a humble priest (somehow considered the descendant of the fictional *Don Quixote*!) who like that ancestor sets out on an improbable journey across Spain, accompanied by a sidekick. Although recently elevated by a quirk of fate to the rank of Monsignor, the priest is actively disliked by his bishop and essentially has no standing in the Church whatsoever. His companion is a devout communist, recently voted out of office as the town's mayor. Despite their differences, the two get along wonderfully.

The communist confesses to having been drawn to the priest because "I thought you were the opposite of myself." Among his fellows, he said, "We quoted Marx and Lenin to one another like passwords to prove we could be trusted, and we never spoke of the doubts which came to us on sleepless nights. I was drawn to you because I thought you were a man without doubts."

However, the priest confesses to being "riddled by doubts." And that's okay, he maintains. Doubt is only human. In fact, "It's an awful thing not to have doubts."

My thoughts on this began to gel when I read [another reader review](#), which says, "When it comes down to it, belief in something does not really require the existence of the thing one believes in. In the words of another priest in the novel, a Trappist monk: 'I suppose Descartes brought me to the point where he brought himself—to faith. Fact or fiction—in the end you can't distinguish between them—you just have to choose.'"

When I read that, I went off on a tangent thinking of a problematic line at the end of the kids'

Christmas movie *Polar Express*: "One thing about trains: It doesn't matter where they're going. What matters is deciding to get on." That claim troubles me every year when I hear it, as it apparently means that the specific star we hitch our wagons to is unimportant. That might be true if some, or perhaps many, beliefs were not destructive.

For example, communism, with which the mayor is proudly affiliated, has been responsible for millions of deaths. He acknowledges that its implementation in the world hasn't gone well. But he insists other beliefs, such as Catholicism, are also flawed and cites the Spanish Inquisition as proof.

I think Greene is suggesting that the problem comes from those who do blindly follow their faith. In the story, the bishop and Father Herrera are simply power-hungry apparatchiks, interchangeable with the party faithful from which the mayor is recoiling.

So this is not an attack on belief, per se. Rather, it's about leaving the shelter of what is comfortable and known, and pursuing that which seems to be "the nearest thing to truth" while understanding that it will always be inextricably mixed with fiction. That being the case, tolerance and love are held up as the model for our interactions.

I was reminded more than once of Greene's [*The Power and the Glory*](#), but in contrast to that the presentation here is genial and mellow -- in keeping with the copious amounts of wine consumed throughout. I'm very glad to have read it.
