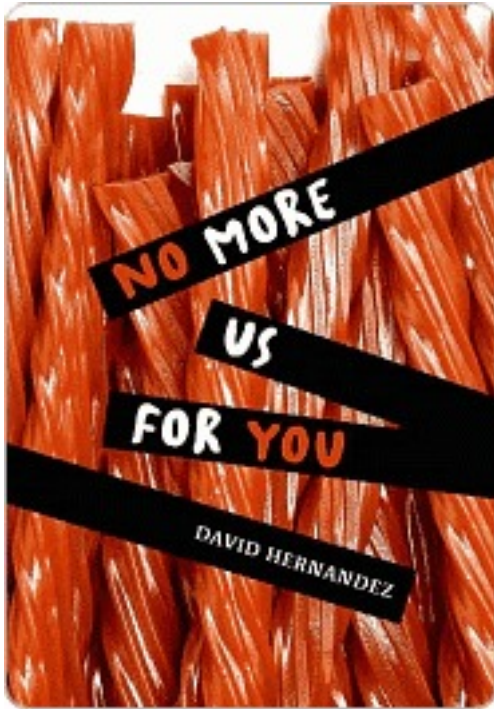

Or I select books by authors who I have read before. And sometimes I find something great that I wasn't even looking for. *No More Us for You* is one such book.
