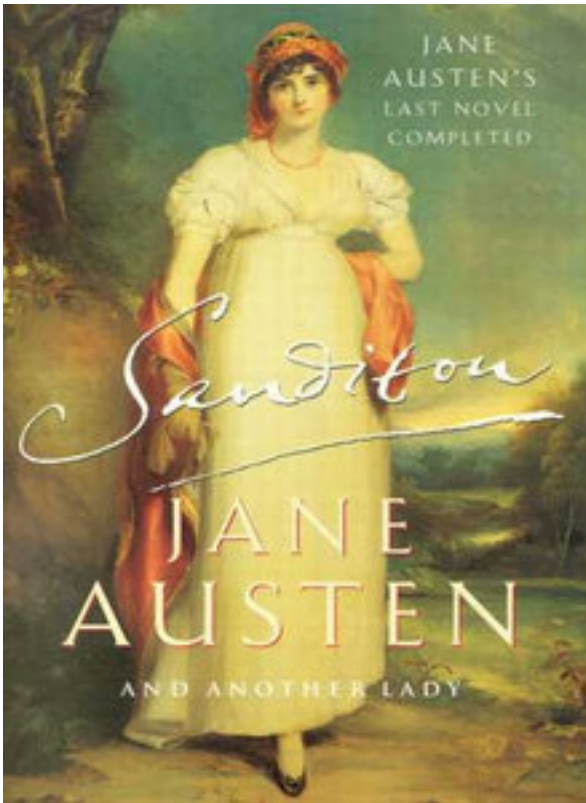

Alex : It's worth noting that this is surprisingly good. Not only do you get 11 chapters of the great woman herself, but you also get an extended Jane Austen pastiche that actually reads a lot like an Austen novel - that is until it all breaks down into a hackneyed denouement wherein all of the characters behave in extraordinary ways and think nothing of it. When the main love interest says to Charlotte "will you elope with me" no self respecting Austen heroine would dare say anything other than "ARE YOU OUT OF YOUR FRICKIN MIND?????" and the guy that tried to abduct her would have been more than a little disgraced methinks.

Yet the other lady introduces some great characters and for many chapters really nails a heroine that one would truly believe was Austenian (apart from a few passages of overdone introspection) whilst the main love interest, Sidney Parker has a lovely way in manipulation and machination that really nicely recalled one of Austen's later novels.

This is by no means an essential book. The work of Austen is fragmentary and whilst it offers an insight into intriguing new directions for her as an author, it's not a developed concept. The work of the author lady is completely enjoyable, but it is pastiche and it is flawed. However, if you enjoy reading Austen, then this is probably worth your time.

I'm sure the story line was close to what Jane Austen would have done -- lots of tension, broken hearts, regrets and happy endings (except for the scoundrel in the story) -- but I thought the "Other Lady" got a little sloppy in style as she went along. A fun beach read, though.

Meredith (Austenique Reviews): It is always regrettable when a great author, composer, or artist leaves an unfinished work, especially when that work has the potential to become a masterpiece. Jane Austen began penning the novel "Sanditon" or, "The Brothers" as it was originally titled, during the last few months of her life. It was unfortunately abandoned around chapter eleven due to her declining health. In these precious chapters we are introduced to a new seaside resort called Sanditon, an emerging community that offers seaside pleasures such as sea-bathing and picturesque walks. In addition, this fragment is brimming with Austen's customary array of diverting characters along with her ironic and satirical tone which is more biting and burlesque than ever!

Fortunately for us Janeites, several authors have attempted to continue this remarkable and promising fragment and have fleshed it out into a complete novel. These authors include: Julia

Barrett, Helen Baker, Juliette Shapiro, and the one this review is for "Another Lady." Another Lady (presumed to be a Marie Dobbs) continues the story of Sanditon where Jane Austen left off. Ms. Dobbs is quite excellent at capturing the satire and wicked wit of Jane Austen. Furthermore, she brilliantly maintained Jane Austen's cleverly crafted characters and the concluded it all as if it was predesignated by Austen, herself.

If you are apprehensive about the consistency of switching authors mid-book, you need not worry. I found it very hard to decipher where Jane Austen left off and where Ms. Dobbs began. Moreover, I don't think I have ever read any Jane Austen Fan Fiction, sequel, or para-literature that has come as close to emulating Jane Austen's style, tone, and language as this continuation.

Our heroine, Charlotte Heywood, at the age of twenty-two, is invited to enjoy a summer holiday in Sanditon by a Mr. and Mrs. Parker, who met Charlotte as a result of their carriage accident near her home. Charlotte is a sensible and observant young woman who, occasionally, can be a little too quick in her judgments and perceptions. In Sanditon, she makes many new acquaintances with a wide variety of personalities and demeanors to practice her skills of observation and perception on such as: a family of hypochondriacs, a self-proclaimed lothario, and a lively young man who is a master at manipulating and managing his family and friends. Poor Charlotte discovers that whenever she is around this lively young man – the handsome, teasing, and charming Sidney Parker – her levelheadedness and sensibleness dissipates. It seems as though the sensible and cautious Charlotte is in for a little unexpected romance on her summer holiday...

"Sanditon" by Jane Austen and Another Lady is an exceptional continuation that was accomplished with great finesse, adroitness, and homage. I consider this book a MUST-read for Jane Austen fans!

Quasi un ritorno all'ironia non dico degli *Juvenilia*, ma delle opere più giovanili; un'ironia che in *Mansfield Park*, forse in step with through del diverso carattere di Fanny, period meno evidente, anche se, pensando a *leave out Bates*, Mr. Woodhouse e Mary Musgrove, non si può dire, in effetti, che mancasse in *Emma* o *Pesuasione*. Lady Denham sembrava un vero tesoro da esplorare, un ridicolo combine tra girl Catherine de Bourgh e Mrs. Norris con un'ostinazione cieca e meschina che non si vede l'ora di veder gabbata. La lettera che pass over Diana Parker scrive al fratello Thomas, il responsabile dello spostamento della protagonista a Sanditon, è un piccolo capolavoro: con il suo dileggio all'ipocondria ci presenta tre fantastici personaggi secondari, Diana, Susan e Arthur Parker, che incontreremo in seguito e che si riveleranno tre piccole perle austeniane da cui è difficile staccarsi. Il "mistero" di *leave out Bereton*, l. a. nipote di girl Denham, appena accennato prima della tremendous del frammento, fa quasi pensare a Jane Fairfax, e questo è decisamente un ottimo punto di partenza according to un autore di sequel. La *Dobbs/Telscombe* è stata poi molto brava a mescolare le carte in modo molto scaltro, fondendo capitoli e proseguendo senza soluzione di continuità, in modo che, chi non ha mai letto il frammento di Sanditon, non riuscirà a capire dove questo finisca. In realtà, in quei pochi capitoli, Jane Austen già dà un accenno alle forti volontà che popolano il romanzo. Tutti i Parker sembrano essere grandi organizzatori e un po' manipolatori, e così woman Denham, dall'alto del suo titolo e delle sue ricchezze. Partendo da questa caratteristica comune nella famiglia Parker e prendendo a prestito l'ironia un po' canzonatoria di uno dei protagonisti più apprezzati di Jane Austen medesima, Henry Tilney, l'Altra Signora/Marie Dobbs/Anne Telscombe ha modellato un protagonista maschile molto ben riuscito, che non sembra discostarsi dai canoni austeniani, eppure è diverso dagli altri sette (se si tiene presente che in *Ragione e sentimento* i protagonisti maschili sono due). Immaginate dunque un Henry Tilney che ha in step with fratelli i Parker così come ce li ha presentati Jane Austen nel frammento... l. a. miscela è esplosiva, e Sidney, pur non nascondendo l'affetto verso fratelli e sorelle, non potrà non prendere in giro i loro atteggiamenti. Ma Sidney ha anche qualcosa da nascondere - come uno dei villain di Jane Austen o come Edward Ferrars - oltre a una carica di simpatia irresistibile. Come Frank Churchill, Sidney Parker arriva a Sanditon dopo essere stato invitato numerosissime volte dal fratello e aver declinato l'offerta, preferendo l'angoscia vita sociale più attiva di Londra. E proprio come Frank Churchill, Sidney ha i suoi buoni motivi in keeping with visitare con l'amico Henry Brudenall l'angoscia cittadina sul mare. Sidney racconterà ai parenti le pene d'amore dell'amico, che è dovuto andar through da Londra in line with non vedere l'angoscia cugina di cui è innamorato sposata a un altro. Henry Brudenall, come James Benwick in *Pesuasione* è dunque giustificato consistent with l'angoscia sua quasi totale asocialità, anche se, al contrario del capitano Benwick, che pian piano si apre e chiacchiera con Anne Elliot, Brudenall terrà con Charlotte Heywood un comportamento più simile a quello di Mr. Palmer verso le signorine Dashwood in *Ragione e sentimento*. Insomma, ci sarebbe da parlare in keeping with ore dei combine che Marie Dobbs ha saputo creare nei personaggi consistent with renderli austeniani (come, in keeping with esempio, le due sorelle Beaufort, un eccellente miscuglio delle sorelle Steele con le due pass over Bennet più giovani e una spruzzata di Harriet Smith), ma il personaggio più riuscito è decisamente lei, Charlotte Heywood. La protagonista unisce le caratteristiche di molte delle eroine austeniane. È

un'osservatrice della natura umana, proprio come Elizabeth Bennet, ma è più riservata di lei e, malgrado si sia formata un'opinione ben decisa su molte delle persone che incontra a Sanditon, l. a. tiene in keeping with sé, senza mai giudicarle spietatamente. Anzi, si comporta un po' da Jane Bennet, quando arriva a essere scioccata dai commenti canzonatori di Sidney verso i propri fratelli, malgrado, nel profondo del suo cuore abbia pensato di loro esattamente le stesse cose. È molto gentile e sempre disponibile in line with gli altri, anche ignorando i propri desideri, proprio come Anne Elliot e Fanny Price. Ed è ingenua come Catherine Morland, ma mai stupida. Questo compendio di eroina austeniana non sarà forse il risultato finale che avrebbe raggiunto Jane Austen se avesse potuto portare a compimento Sanditon, ma è tuttavia un surrogato molto credibile, di cui è molto facile accontentarsi. Alcuni hanno detto che los angeles soluzione finale dell'Altra Signora è poco austeniana, ma io l'ho trovata originale e non del tutto estranea alla Austen. Dopo tutto, ho già detto che los angeles Clara Bereton profilata da Jane Austen mi somigliava a Jane Fairfax, quindi da lei ci potremmo aspettare di tutto, no? Ma non voglio fare spoiler, quindi taccio. Perché spero ardentemente che questo romanzo completato da Marie Dobbs venga tradotto in italiano, dal momento che è uno dei sequel più belli e divertenti che abbia mai letto!
