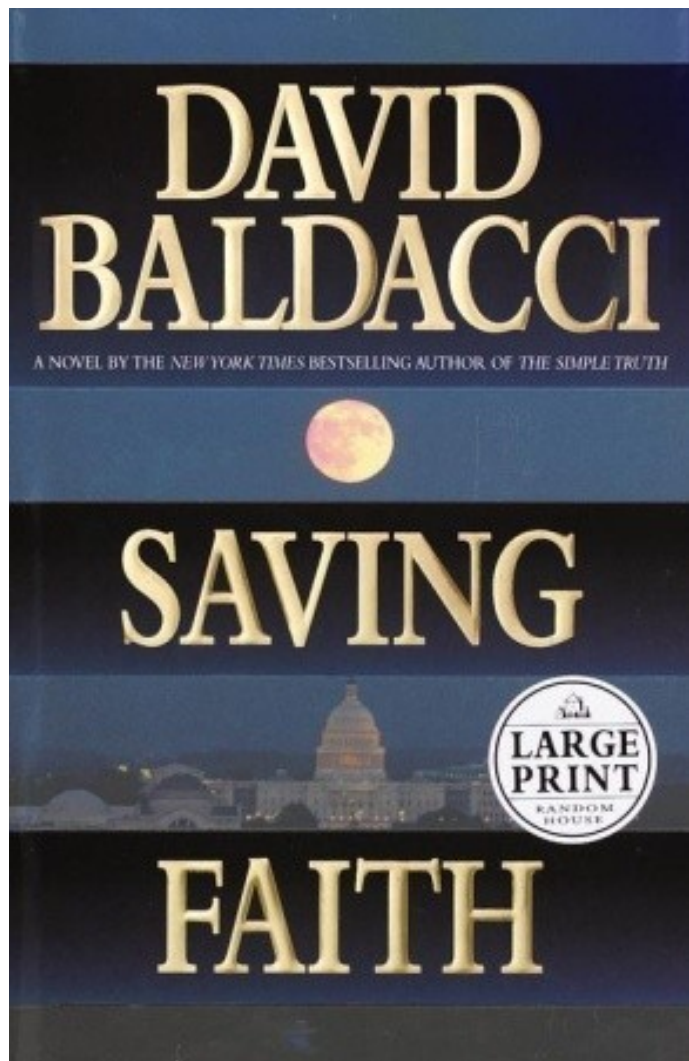

I was bummed Baldacci put in the F word. I've read a few of his books and have admired the way he can write a good suspense, action novel without a lot of swearing. This book was written in 1999 and I hope it is not indicative of where he goes in more recent novels.

This is also the first novel I've read with romance and sex in it. Naturally, I liked that.

The last 100 pages really had my attention. It just took awhile for me to get to that point.

Marta: Take aways: The hero, Lee Adams, is the classical tall, tough loner. There are bad guys hidden among the good guys (teh CIA and politicians-although are they really considered good guys these days?) There is a heroine, Faith Lockhart, who is good looking in an approachable way and in trouble over her head. Guns shoot, people die, Faith and Lee go on the lam. For thriller fans, I think it has all the right stuff. This isn't my bag so I'm a bit on the outside looking in. I would like this as a movie- a two hour investment (a little under what I spent reading it) versus many hours of thorough reading. This would be a reasonable cross over for Lee Childs, although Jack Reacher is more formidably tough.

The tale encompasses a younger woman named religion Lockhart, and her mentor/father-figure Danny Buchanan –
