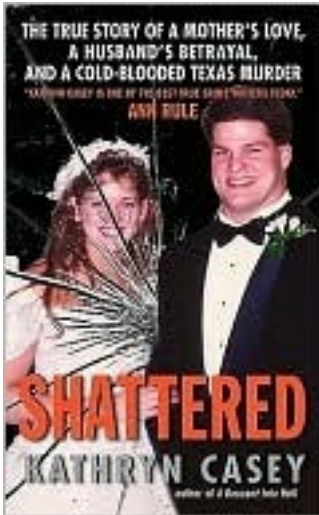

The fairy tale ended savagely on January 11, 1999, when Belinda's lifeless body was discovered in a closet. Her skull had been shattered by a shotgun blast at close range. She was eight months pregnant.

There was no damning evidence directly linking the brutal murder to husband David, who stood by emotionless and dry-eyed as police searched the crime scene. But a dogged eight-year investigation would expose a shocking history of cruelty and domination, infidelity and rage—ultimately resulting in an epic courtroom battle for the ages—as the scandalous truth was revealed about love betrayed and innocent lives . . . shattered.

Belinda did abandon her parents, her family only to please her husband. She even told her twin sister not to come on their birthday because his majesty did not want it. The twins did not celebrate their birthday at their parents but at the house of Belinda's parents in law. So Belinda was indeed a normal human being and there was no need to keep on writing how sweet and innocent she was.

Then back to the story and the book. I liked it a lot. One of the better books by Mrs Casey. I liked the second part most. Wanted to find out how they would get him, how the trial would go. Normally that is not the case. so I will give this book 4 stars cause at the end I could not put it down..

Fire Lyte: While Casey is a gifted crime writer, she lacks the ability to make us care about the people in her book. The first part of the book is devoted to telling us about the players in the drama - who they were, where they came from, and how they became the people they were at the time of the murder.

This entire backstory portion is very poorly written, seeming, at times, like a high school book report on the lives of these people and not a thoroughly researched narrative about actual people. She glosses over interesting portions of these people's lives while going into exhausting detail on what seems like incredibly mundane points. (Did we really need multiple descriptions, several sentences long, about the Papacita's menu? I guess she liked the food.)

The author also includes vague, uninteresting quotes from anonymous sources that almost sound made up they're so bland, adding nothing to the narrative.

What I couldn't forgive about the first half of the book, however, was Casey's insertion of details that she even admitted had no factual basis. A true crime book should be as close to fact as possible, with little editorial license. Except, in this case, the author continued on an almost Nancy Grace level tear about David's possible high school steroid use and how methodical he was during football training, trying to get us to believe that - despite having zero evidence of the former - these were nonetheless true points and indicative of later criminality.

What I found odd, since she spent so much time trying to hammer home fake points, was that she glossed over what any Criminal Justice 101 student would identify as potential sociopathic behavior. She could have gone in depth on David's possible killing of animals as a youngster, but didn't. Multiple times she could have gone into greater breadth on interesting, unique matters...and chose to give us a page long description of the seasoning used on the chicken at Papacita's instead.

Oddly enough, Casey switches gears once the actual crime takes place, and then the novel becomes almost edge-of-your-seat exciting. She obviously has a professional crush on the prosecutor, as the latter half of the trial details was almost a love story to the woman's brilliance. The bread and butter of the novel is the trial, where the author nails the accused to the wall. It's well-written and well-executed.

One note: I listened to the audiobook. The narrator has obviously never heard a southern accent before in her life, and had no idea how to pronounce words like Brookshire's grocery store. Obviously there were typos in the book, because the narrator actually pronounced the typos exactly as written, which was jarring to listen to. So...if you're listening to this, I warn you now the narration itself is so bad it distracts from the story.

Libby Gordon: I don't read a lot of true crime anymore because they are usually badly written . This one, although not extremely well-written , intrigued me because the young couple in this story -David and Belinda Temple- met and graduated from Stephen F. Austin State University a short time after my husband and I met there and eventually married.

Belinda Lucas thought David Temple was the perfect man to share her life and raise a family. He was a star football player from Katy High School and had a successful college ball career at SFA. They married during their senior year and eventually he became a football coach and she a high school special ed teacher . They seemed to live an idyllic married life on the surface with their three year-old son Evan and Baby Erin on the way but on January 11,1999, Belinda is

found by her husband in their master bedroom closet dead from a close contact shotgun blast and her 8 month fetus, Baby Erin, is also dead. It is soon brought to light that their marriage isn't as great as it seemed to be and David emerges as the prime suspect.
