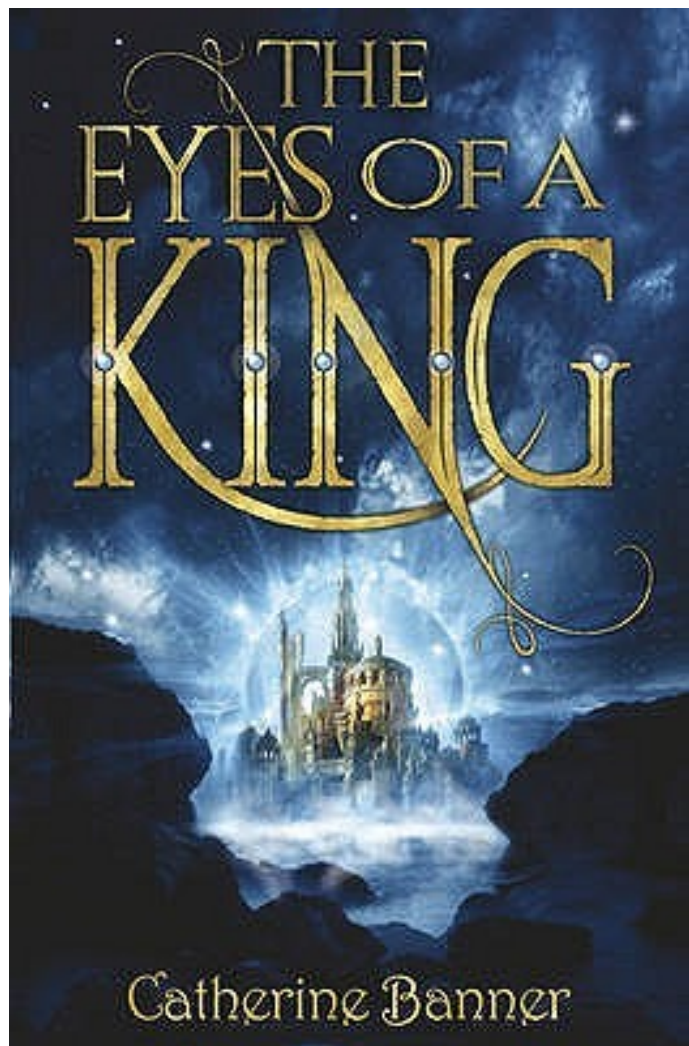

I had an issue with the back and fourth between worlds and characters. It was easy to follow, but I feel like Anna and Cassius (Ryan) got the short end of the stick. Where to begin?

For a young author, this book was very well written. The vocabulary was versatile and added to the story. Banner's style didn't distract from the book, but it wasn't too developed (as expected from a younger author). Her description was perfect.

I did enjoy that it changed its pov throughout, not giving away too many plot points at a time in order to bring in suspense for the reader. The only thing that I disliked about this is that it didn't allow for a deep connection some of the other characters.

The plot was fairly predictable up till some of the ending points, and some of the plot points seemed unnecessary and drawn out.

The setting was believable and the character's problems were very realistic. Her character description was shown, not told, a problem many young authors encounter. Aside from a general dislike of the main character, who seemed a bit whiny to me (though this is personal preference), the characters were likable and their emotions reflected to the reader.
