

Katie Ann: Christians forget that the Bible was not available to the mass market for many many years. This novel tells about the start of the John Wycliffe movement that changed the face of Christianity forever.

Betty Strohecker: Set in late 14th century England, this first novel by Brenda Rickman Vantrease is a masterful telling of medieval society with its strict mores regarding cultural, political, and religious life. As a widow, Lady Kathryn must struggle to hold onto her land and provide a future for her children while following the dictates of church and king. She agrees to house widower Finn, a master illuminator, and his daughter as a favor to the local abbot while Finn illustrates manuscripts for the church. Secretly, Finn is copying a forbidden English translation of the Bible that would put all of their lives in danger if discovered. As Kathryn and Finn grow close, treachery, deceit, and betrayal threaten to destroy all they have hoped for.

This novel tells in graphic detail events of the time and keeps the reader wondering from the beginning to the end how it will turn out. Characters are bold, brave, and unforgettable as the reader becomes involved in their story. This was a wonderful book filled with plot twists and emotion.

His uncles, John of Gaunt, and Thomas of Glouster, vied for strength through the Protectorate, the younger King's minority. in the meantime all Christianity used to be anguish in the course of the nice Schism. Pope Boniface VIII and King Philip the reasonable of France heavily quarreled, to place it mildly, approximately Church tithing and taxation. Finally, Boniface declared the primacy of the Church over secular authorities, the prevalence of Popes over kings. eventually this ended in Popes, one in France and one in Rome. The Church, which had large energy in England, desired to gather extra wealth via tithing. The monarchy wanted to tax the Church's substantial property, and institute an extra ballot tax at the people. As always, the terrible have been penalized most. nearly a century before, in 1297, a mob of villagers and serfs burned out a bunch of Benedictine clergymen who withheld non secular services, together with the Eucharist, pending choices they can no longer afford.
