

Suzanne: I kept expecting this book to begin or become whatever it was meant to be. I thought that it would involve some measure of fantasy or fable that would provide the reader with a transformative experience. Instead this is a really dark book that begins with a grim outlook and continues in the same unyielding vein. The protagonist goes on a journey, from and to where we don't really know. When we don't really know either. She learns to read and write while on this journey but mostly she is tortured, literally, and treated like a slave. After reading, I was left wondering, "why?" I received this from Netgalley.

Kirsten Jensen: Jo Baker, the bestselling author of Longbourn, has definitely wrote a sour tale of a young girls journey to find her mermaid mother, enthralling readers with raw characters and non-stop danger. Not to mention that until about half way into the novel the reader still is not exactly told if Malin or a boy or girl – thus making this crazy novel more absurd. Sadly, this book was not what I expected. I found it has hard to get in to, and that it lacked excitement.

Lindley: This book was quite different from what I expected, based on the description. When it's described as a fairy tale for adults, think more Grimm than Disney. Malin's journey is a hard one, full of both pain and pleasure, love and cruelty. Jo Baker does not shy away from the most difficult parts of the journey, and at times I found it a bit hard to read. Although many parts of this book are beautifully written, I had this feeling as though there was a wall between Malin and the reader--it was hard for me to ever connect with the character. For such a driven character, it seemed like events happened to her for the majority of the story, rather than her having a real sense of agency. Malin developed more control over her life toward the end of the story, but it ended quite abruptly.
