Naomi Bennet: Ahhh! This book has it's faults, but it's so cute and re-reading it made me be a little girl again. (Seriously, I'd forgotten how much I used to love this book. I knew some bits by heart. :-D)

What I liked:

- 1. The characters are all jolly nice. Katy sometimes gets on my nerves, because she REALLY is impossible, and Aunt Helen is too perfect (heh), but they're all nice, in the end. I love Aunt Izzy, don't kill me. She was just hilarious, and her dry remarks about Katy made me giggle. What I didn't like:

- 1. As I said, Katy sometimes made me a bit impatient. Her recklessness IS a bit... over the top. :-P
- 2. The book has a bit of an Elsie-Dinsmore-vibe, as many old children's books do. You know, stuff like, "Oh! Papa! I promise never ever to be wicked and selfish again!" etc. It can make you squirm a bit.
- 3. Some bits are slightly boring like all the poems. I skimmed those. I don't like poems, I don't.

Christopher: Perhaps a bit saccharine and overtly moralistic for the modern reader but still, a good and nice story about a girl who learns the meaning of 'selflessness.' Read as part of the LOST book club for insight into 'Kate.'

CLM: This series is much more popular in England than in the US, despite being set in what seems to be a small New England town. Perhaps because reading about a girl who is bedridden is not the most exciting thing; however, I always enjoyed it.
